Cover Letter for Application for Research Grant or for Conducting a Child Health Project.

Therefore, you must aim to give the letter an enthusiastic tone and show appreciation for the funder's consideration. Present your organization's character through your writing, but also demonstrate your professionalism for which it requires deliberation and smart decision-making. The research that you propose to do should be a child health priority of the government of Nepal.

General Tips

Introduce yourself and provide background information, state your purpose for the proposal, define your goals and objectives, highlight what sets you apart, briefly discuss the budget and how funds will be used, Finish with a call to action and request a follow-up, Close the letter and provide contact details.
